The Pension Rights Center is a nonprofit consumer organization that has been working since 1976 to protect and promote the retirement security of American workers, retirees, and their families.

The Center strongly supports the new information requirements for terminating single employer plans requested by the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation. As noted in our July 30, 2014 comment letter to the PBGC (linked in its request), additional information will better enable the PBGC to respond to participants and beneficiaries seeking information about their benefits under terminated defined benefit pension plans. The additional information on benefit distributions, annuity providers, and the participants entitled to an annuity from each provider, will help participants and beneficiaries locate their benefits.

We encourage OMB to approve this request for additional information requirements from terminating single employer plans.
